

International Research Experience for Students



Eligibility



Conduct 10 - 12 weeks paid chemical or materials science research in Germany or Singapore



Participate in multiple professional development opportunities before, during, and after the research experience



Immerse yourself in the life and culture of another country while gaining professional experience from faculty and graduate student mentors

About the program

ACS International Research Experience for Students (IRES) is an NSF-funded summer research opportunity for undergraduates. It is managed by ACS in collaboration with the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) and the National University of Singapore.



Full-time undergraduate student majoring in chemistry or allied field



Current sophomore or junior (must be a rising junior or senior by the end of Summer 2023)



10 or more weeks of prior research experience



US citizen or permanent resident

Applicants do **not** need international travel experience, ACS membership, or fluency in German, Malay, or Chinese.
