Reminders



- Automated meeting captions are available with all Zoom packages (even the free version)
- Use the desktop client rather than the web-based application to host your meetings
- Make sure you are logged in as the host when you start the meeting
- Adjust your meeting settings in advance at <u>zoom.us</u> rather than the live-meeting settings
- It takes more than automated tools to make your meetings more accessible to people with disabilities


Enabling Captions



- 1. Enable accessibility features within your profile
 - a) Log in at zoom.us
 - b) Navigate to advanced meeting settings
 - c) Search for and enable captions and interpretation features

Where to adjust your settings






Live Meeting Caption Settings



Prepare for the method you'd like to use day-of:

- a) Auto-captioning
- b) Third party captioning
- c) Manual captioning
- d) Language interpretation (including sign language)



Additional best practices and tips



- Use meeting or webinar registration features whenever possible and ask required accommodations (ok to leave open-ended)
- Don't assume that captions will cover all needs for people that are hard of hearing or Deaf
 - Use slide deck prompts to provide additional visual cues
 - Slow down
- Test out these features in advance to see what to expect
- When recording a Zoom meeting, edit the transcript for typos and major mistakes (make sure the transcript is viewable)






What provides the most value?



Key Points to Working With Industry



- Funding comes from the inside
 - Easiest way to gain industry funding from ERGs, departments, or companies is if it's pitched by employees
- Event planning needs a minimum of 9 months for execution
 - Industry will have red tape even with branding!
- Aligning with industry vision and mission helps to gain support from upper management
 - Employees can receive travel funding, membership coverage, or be able to allocate a percentage of time to work on ACS activities. Sometimes participation can help with promotions!
- Micro-volunteering opportunities can help prevent burnout
 - More people = more support = more success
- Understanding the why can help to recruit volunteers
 - What's the motivation for volunteering?

Potential Barriers:

- Middle management really drives participation
- Changes in the chain of command can change participation and funding






