



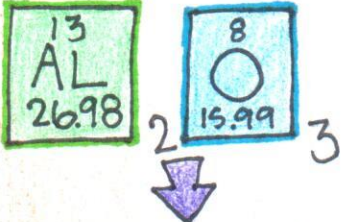
The Chemistry of Rocks

Both gems are made of Corundum.

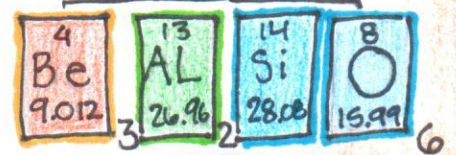


corundum
