

## Chemistry Enterprise Partnership

This Chemistry Enterprise Partnership (“Agreement”) becomes effective on the **1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2020**, by and between the **American Chemical Society (ACS)**, a federally chartered non-profit headquartered at 1155 16<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20036, and the **Chinese American Chemical Society (CACS)**, a 501(c)(3) non-profit headquartered at 18427 Clifton Way, Castro Valley, CA 94546.

ACS and CACS have a shared interest in advancing the chemistry enterprise, and its practitioners, in addressing global challenges confronting humanity. Toward that end, ACS and CACS enter into a three-year Agreement to collaborate in the following areas:


- **Programming Collaboration.** ACS and CACS leaders will explore opportunities to collaborate on programming events related to the United Nations 2030 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) appended to this Agreement with a focus on SDG Goal 4 “Quality Education” and SDG Goal 17 “Partnerships for the Goals.” Mutually agreed upon events shall be in the form of symposia, workshops, webinars, networking events, etc. and shall take place at either ACS or CACS functions and conferences, or other venues.
- **Joint Promotion of Events.** ACS and CACS will mutually promote CACS banquets as networking events at ACS National Meetings; symposia and other events planned for the celebration of the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of CACS in 2021; and any other programming collaboration.
- **Membership Benefits.** ACS and CACS will explore possibilities for mutual benefits for members, such as preferred registration fees for ACS and CACS conferences or short courses, special membership campaigns, discounted membership fees for students, etc. All suggested mutual membership benefits will be subject to the approval of appropriate governing bodies within the respective societies.
