

Chemistry Enterprise Partnership

This Chemistry Enterprise Partnership ("Agreement") is entered into on this 20th day of December, 2018, by and between the **American Chemical Society**, a federally-chartered non-profit headquartered at 1155 16th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20036, USA ("ACS") and the **Indo-U.S. Science & Technology Forum**, Fulbright House, 12 Hailey Road, New Delhi, India 11001 ("IUSSTF").

ACS and IUSSTF have a shared interest in advancing the chemistry enterprise, and its practitioners, in addressing global challenges confronting humanity. Toward that end, ACS and IUSSTF enter into a three-year Agreement to collaborate in the following areas subject to the availability of requisite funding; the underlying theme(s) of the collaborations shall seek to be focused on the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs):

- Establishing an IUSSTF-ACS Fellowship or Visitation Program to nurture contacts between scientists and students from India and the United States and to provide them with high quality research experiences that promote a culture of innovation and scientific inquiry.
- Bilateral Science & Technology Workshop Roundtables in India and/or the US bringing together Indian and US scientists to discuss the role of chemistry in addressing key global challenges and to develop actionable recommendations that can be published in ACS journals.
- Explore possible engagements with industry, such as workshops, symposia, or other forum, to be agreed to by both IUSSTF and ACS, that foster research & development, innovation and entrepreneurship.


