4. Click Show Details for more information about the awards. Included information is the name, sponsor, award description and any questions specific to the award.
5. Click Nominate in the Action column to nominate your event for an award.
6. Answer questions for the award.
7. Add up to 5 files related to the event.
8. Add URLs associated with the event.
9. Click Save for Later, or Complete Nomination Buttons to save the information.

10. Winning Events will be highlighted in FORMS after the ChemLuminary Ceremony.
11. **To edit a nomination:** on the Annual Report page, click the Edit link on the ChemLuminary table.
12. **To withdraw a nomination:** on the Annual Report page, click the Edit link on the ChemLuminary table and click on Withdraw Nomination button in window.

- Committees have defined rules about how many events can be self-nominated for an award or committee. See the details associated with each award for more information.
